



Two Mile Run County Park

Two Mile Run County Park is 2,700 acres of forests and fields surrounding the 144 acre Justus Lake. There are nice facilities, pavilions, camp grounds and a swimming beach.

All divers must register at the park office and obtain a diving permit (\$5.00) which must be displayed on your vehicle. You must sign a waiver for diving at the Park.

Directions from Erie

Two Mile County Park is approximately 63 miles from DW.

- Take Route 19 south to Waterford
- Where Routes 19 and 97 split just past Waterford, stay to the left on Route 97 to Union City.
- In Union City turn right on Route-8 and follow Route for approximately 30 miles (through Titusville).
- Turn right on Route 417 for 3.5 mi. and then turn left on Rt 428.
- In approx. 1.5 mi you will pass a sign for Two Mile Run County Park. Turn right on Cherrytree Road and drive into the park.
- After the small bridge turn left toward the swimming beach.
- Enter the parking lot at Crosby Beach and park near the mini golf.

Directions from Franklin

- Take Route 417 north from Franklin.
- After approximately 6 miles watch for the sign to the park and turn right onto Baker road.
- Follow the sigs to the swimming beach. Enter the parking lot at Crosby Beach and park near the mini golf.

Typical Itinerary

As far in advance as possible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sign up for dive • Reserve rental equipment
Day before planned dive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pick up rental equipment at Diver's World
Day of dive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For those who wish to car pool: meet at Diver's World at 7:45AM. Depart at 8:00AM sharp. • We will meet at the site by 9:30AM • Diving is generally completed by early afternoon. We sometimes meet over lunch to complete log books.
Day after last planned dive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return your rental equipment • Sign up for your next dive

Please note: Times are subject to change; please call Diver's World to sign up and verify the times.

Diving Checklist:

In addition to your normal Scuba Equipment you will want to bring the following:

- dive flag and float
- Dive Knife
- Tarp and Chair

Unless you have specifically called ahead of time to make special arrangements, you must bring your own gear to the site. Diver's World will not bring extra equipment.
